

As you may be aware, the Superfast Berkshire project is part of the Government's subsidised national programme to improve broadband coverage in areas deemed not commercially viable by the private sector. The project is backed by all of the six Berkshire unitary councils and the Thames Valley Berkshire Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP).

Under Phase 1 of the project, Cabinet 40 on the Colnbrook exchange was upgraded to Fibre To The Cabinet (FTTC) by BT Openreach. This cabinet subsequently reached its capacity, however we are pleased to inform you that Openreach has now upgraded the capacity of this cabinet, and there are currently 48 spaces available.

The postcodes that are served by this cabinet are as follows – (please note that not all premises within these postcodes will be able to receive superfast speeds due to distance to the cabinet and infrastructure differences):
